# Chester Norris Lowe

**Birth/Established:** February 2, 1897 **Death/Dissolved:** January 31, 1986

### Biography:

Chester Lowe designed homes in Shaker Heights, Moreland Hills, and Pepper Pike. He lived at 1576 Belmore in East Cleveland, later moving to Bainbridge Township in Geauga County. He retired in 1978, when he moved to Winter Park, Florida.
